Mining and energy projects present an opportunity to change Mozambique and the entire region. Mozambique's oil and gas resources – estimated at 180 trillion cubic feet of natural gas in the Rovuma Basin alone – have the potential to catapult the country into both energy and economic success. The start of production of Liquefied Natural Gas in Area 4 Coral Sul is scheduled for 2022. Mozambique is well-positioned to take advantage of the regional market boom, with mining operations already expanding across Cabo Delgado, Gaza, Manica, Maputo, Nampula, Niassa, Tete and Zambezia. Mozambique is also home to commercially significant deposits of **coal, gold, graphite, ilmenite, iron ore, titanium, nickel, copper, tantalum, lithium, bauxite.**
